Sanjeevini Karnataka State Rural Livelihoods Mission (KSRLM) has been constituted under the aegis of the National Rural Livelihoods Mission in Karnataka in December 2011 with the support of the Government of India, the World Bank and the Government of Karnataka. The Mission aims at eradication of rural poverty by building sustainable institutions of poor and ultimately leading them to sustainable livelihoods.

The mission envisions poverty elimination through social mobilization, institution building, financial inclusion and the creation of several models of sustainable livelihoods. The key task under the mission is to reach out to the rural poor households of Karnataka and stay engaged with them till they come out of poverty. The mission will bring about a paradigm shift in the approach to rural livelihoods and rural poverty eradication in that it engages directly with institutions of poor and empowers them to find lasting solutions to poverty. It sees the poor as the engines of growth rather than mere receivers of aid or being dependent on 'trickle down'. The NRLM believes that poor have the innate capabilities to overcome poverty if they are supported with sensitive, dedicated and responsive institutions at one level and by building strong and sustainable institutions of the poor themselves on the other.

NRLM underlines continuous capacity building of institutions of poor i.e. SHGs and their federations, leaders of these institutions and community resource persons from the institutions. These trainings include SHG concepts, financial literacy, leadership, federations, financial management, Micro Investment Plan/credit plan, communication, conflict resolution etc. Continuous handholding after such trainings ensures strengthening of the SHGs and federations into self reliant institutions.

## **Objective:**

The main objective of this assignment is to ensure quality in the management of community level trainings under the Institution Building and Capacity Building component of NRLM. This would include trainings planned for community institutions (members of SHGs and federations) and community cadre (Community Resource Persons and Bookkeepers). The trainings have to be planned at the state, district, block or Gram Panchayat level.

# Scope of assignment:

The scope of the assignment is to organize and manage all the community level trainings planned for the year under the Institution Building and Capacity Building component of NRLM in coordination with the Sanjeevini KSRLM staff. This would include planning the logistics (travel, boarding and lodging, availability of training materials) of the trainings, communication regarding trainings, coordinating with the training venue and resource persons identified by Sanjeevini KSRLM, coordinating with the field level staff of Sanjeevini KSRLM and ensuring smooth execution of planned trainings.

He/she shall be responsible for the following deliverables:

- Develop a work plan listing all the community trainings planned for the year 2014-15 and 2015-16.
- Take stock of the resource persons identified by Sanjeevini KSRLM to ensure quality and availability of the same in order to complete the said trainings.
- Take stock of the materials and manuals developed by Sanjeevini KSRLM to ensure availability of the same.
- Timely planning of logistics for all the trainings.
- Ensure qualitative and successful completion of all community level trainings planned by Sanjeevini KSRLM for the year 2014-15 and 2015-16.
